

Powder Coating vs. Liquid Coating

Key benefits of powder coatings as an excellent alternative to a liquid coating are:

- Powder coats offer uniform coverage and thickness, durability, and high quality finish.
- Powder coated surfaces are more resistant to chipping, scratching, fading, and wearing than other finishes.
- Powder coating is a one-coat process applied over a phosphatized surface that meets or exceeds the corrosion resistance of a comparable liquid coat.
- Primers are not necessary and gone are the sags, runs, or drips typical with a liquid coating.
- Powder coatings are VOC (volatile organic compounds) and solvent free and are very environmentally friendly.
- Polyester powders exhibit excellent mar and chip resistance and toughness along with long term resistance to humidity and corrosion.
